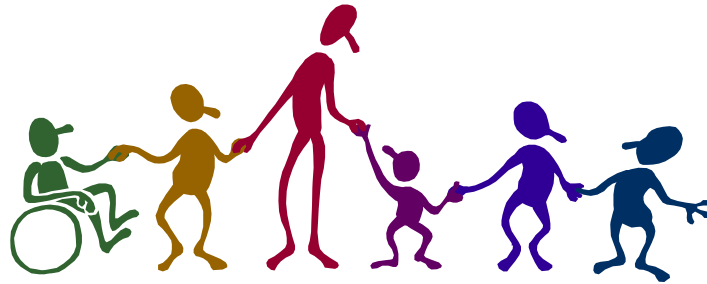


Celebrating Diversity

1. I agree that the above-identified piece of artwork is to be entered in the Celebrating Diversity Art Show.
2. By signing here below, I agree that the COD Cultural Competency Workgroup members may display my artwork at the show, open to the public from October 24-26.
3. If my piece is the First Place winning entry, I grant AMDD the unrestricted right to photograph or otherwise reproduce my art for use in promotional materials.
4. I understand that the Cultural Competency Workgroup members and AMDD Community Program Officers will receive, store, and display my artwork at the show in a careful manner and at safe locations. I also understand that the Cultural Competency Workgroup members and Community Program Officers are not responsible for damage to or theft of my artwork, whether in transit before or after the show, or during the show.

I agree that I will sign for and pick up my artwork on October 26th between 10 and Noon, or make alternate arrangements. **If someone is picking up my artwork for me, I will send a signed written statement with that person stating that they can pick up my work.** (This includes the person who transported your artwork to the show.)
